摘要

2007 年度國際警察首長(IACP)年會在美國路易斯安那州紐奧良市(New Orleans City, Louisiana, USA)舉行,其過程如下:

- 註冊:我國此次參加者除本校代表由謝校長指派行政警察學系朱主任金池及 外事警察學系蔡主任庭榕。於1月13日到達後立即前往現場辦理註冊手續。
- 2、開幕儀式:由 IACP 現任會長 Joseph C. Carter 主持,並有紐奧良市警察局局長 Warren J. Riley 等貴賓上台致詞,場面隆重盛大。我國除本校代表外,尚有內政部警政署洪副署長勝堃、外事組陳組長瑞通;航警局郭局長嘉助及羅科長火祥;以及法務部調查局葉局長盛茂及外事室莊銘主任等人參與盛會。
- 3、參加警政工作研討會:大會安排有關警政領導、警察教育訓練及犯罪分析等 各項主題之研討會,內容豐富,可自由參加聽講,本校亦前往代表參加相關 教育訓練研討。
- 4、參觀警察裝備器材展覽:在硬體方面有警察各項裝備器材,在軟體方面有民間各種警察教育訓練機構、員警評鑑中心顧問公司、勤務排班軟體公司等,以及美國聯邦執法機關,如聯邦調查局(FBI)及國土安全部(DHS)所屬之各相關執法機構,如秘情局(U.S. Secret Service)及運輸安全部(Transportation Security Administration)等各種攤位,應有盡有,資料非常豐富。
- 5、蒐集 IACP 陳列之各項出版物:會場陳列 IACP 有關警政及犯罪研究之各項出版品, 免費供與會人員自由索取, 相關資料均即有助於我國警察教育、訓練之參考。

壹、 目的

IACP 每年年會均有許多嶄新的研發產品與教育、訓練新趨向,對於負責治安與秩序維持之警政教育、訓練部門極具參考效能。我國中央警察大學(CPU)是負責培育國家治安幹部與研究發展之重要學府,而且本校畢業學生的工作領域包括:內政部警政署、消防署、移民署、行政院海巡署、法務部所屬各監獄、看守所,甚至國家安全局與外交部等相關政府重要部門。特別是在九一一恐怖攻擊之後,各國對於攸關處理國家安全、社會安寧與人民安危等事項均極爲重視,特別是國土安全與治安維護方面,本校更應因應全球化的趨勢,國內執法體系與相關職權作爲更應隨著不斷修正,有關執法設備器材更應隨之更新。警察教育的國際化與現代化已刻不容緩,透過參與國際警察首長協會研究執法理論與實務相關內涵,特別是藉由參與國際會議瞭解最新警察教育、訓練與執法技能等新知,以充實我國警察教育、訓練之內涵,是出席第114屆國際警察首長協會(International Association of Chiefs of Police,簡稱 IACP)年會的主要目的。

IACP 長期協助有關警察執法人員的教育、訓練,特別是關於警察單位的領導統御及其他與治安相關之警察專業教育或訓練方面,藉由國際警察首長會議研討,分享各項心得與經驗,以增強警政工作品質與解決治安問題的能耐。另一方面,IACP 更聯合各相關國土安全有關領域專業,研發各種科技、設備設備,進而結合重大災難防救之安全管理機制研發,特別是以天然與人爲之重大災難爲目標,例如反恐與地震等議題爲研究重心。再者,在治安與交通秩序維護方面,對於刑案偵辦之技術與程序,在學理與實務上之結合,均有許多研發,例如,毒品偵查與酒駕查辦之技巧與程序等。藉由 IACP 之年度會議,透過各國警察首長及美國各地警察首長之會議研討,並進而進行員警教育訓練,提供新穎器材設備及教育訓練軟體資料,供各參與國代表攜回參考。除了執法設備與教育訓練之外,對於如何保障人權,有效實施正當法律程序等議題,均極重視。











參、感想與建議

一、國際警察首長協會(IACP)經過了114屆的研究發展,結合世界各國警 政首長與菁英共同研討與分享成果與經驗,並進一步提供許多執法新知 與相關服務。特別值得一提的是在五日的會議期間,執法重要議題的討 論與交換心得具有他山之石的參考效果;又大規模的警用科技展覽中亦可直接獲取最新的設備與器材資訊,供國內警方採購之參考,此對於改進警察執法品質與效能應極有幫助,對於肩負警察幹部教育訓練之中央警察大學,在教學、研究上具有重要意義,明(2008)年第115屆 IACP 年會將在美國聖地牙哥市舉行,建請續派員參加與國際警察首長交流,並促進彼此友誼。

- 二、我國在辦理國際警察學術研討會或審查學術刊物而需要邀請國際知名研究警政的專家時,可考慮直接透過 IACP 之協助,請求推薦相關領域的專家參與。由於我國之國際處境較爲困難,透過屬於國際警察首長協會之互動與分享,亦可使得我國國際警政合作與有效打擊不法,得到良好進步發展。
- 三、美國 Harris 郡之警政學院(Police Academy)的相關訓練課程值得進一步參考與學習,特別是對於招募之資格條件與實務訓練部分,更是符合警政實務功能需求,相當值得台灣效法參考。特別是該學院之射擊設施與訓練內容,包括手槍射擊、電腦模擬情境射擊、屋內情境射擊、室外車輛追逐射擊,及步槍射擊等五項,可供本校借鏡。美國(如德州)警察訓練之體檢標準及課程內容、時數之標準,可供我國參考。
- 四、美國德州 Sam Houston State University(SHSU)刑事司法學院 Huntsville 市 Sam Houston State University(SHSU)以警政、犯罪學研究及獄政管理聞名全美,而美國德州休斯頓市休斯頓大學城中校區(UHD)之公共事務學院及刑事司法系均與本校有姊妹校關係,未來可進一步加強學術交流及人員互訪或交會教授等作爲,以強化本校教學與研究。除續與UHD和 SHSU 兩校相互交流外,建請拓展與美國設有刑事司法(Criminal Justice)博士班的其他大學建立姊妹校的關係,尤其若能爭取知名教授來本校講學,將有助於我國警察學術之發展。
