- 3.The MTNet project of Chinese Taipei,PCS project of India, SafeSeaNet project are intrduced as the reference project of AFACT Single Window environment project. The Participated member recommend that there should have one system like SafeSeaNet System to exchange Transportaion information between AFACT members.

- 4. The participated members from India recommended to share the following MIS reports between the member countries.
 - (1)Turn Round Time of Vessels
 - (2) Pre Berthing Detention of Vessels
 - (3) Output per Ship Berth Day
 - (4). Moves per Hour in respect of Containers.
 - (5). Daily position of vessels calling/departing at/from the Ports.
 - (6) Cargo/Container Throughput.

Standardized Cross-Border Messages/Documents is the important step toward AFACT single window environment.
