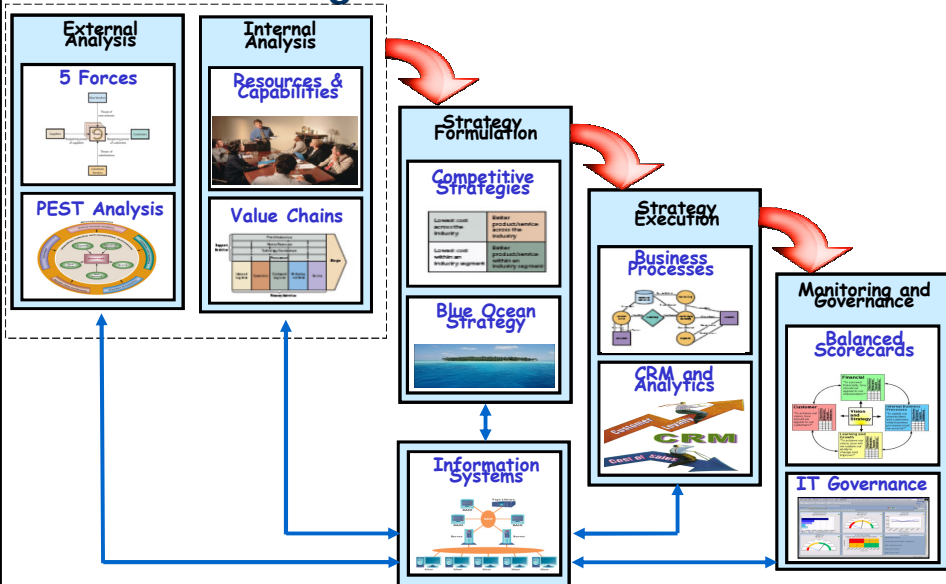

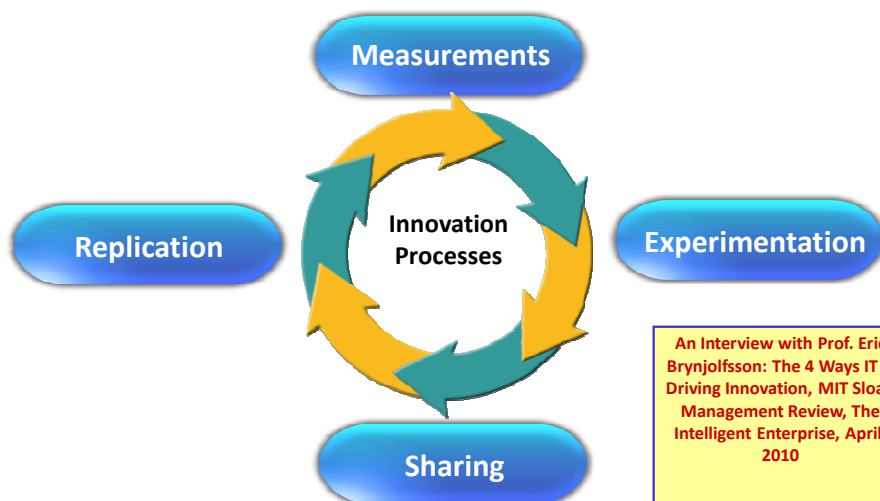

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## Cloud | Greatest Value is Innovation Enabling |

### SaaS

#### Software Delivery Model

Increasingly popular with SMEs

- No hardware or software to manage
- Service delivered through a browser

### PaaS

#### Platform Delivery Model

- Platforms are built upon Infrastructure, which is expensive
- Estimating demand is not a science!
- Platform management is not fun!

### IaaS

#### Computer Infrastructure Delivery Model

Access to infrastructure stack:

- Full OS access
- Firewalls
- Routers
- Load balancing

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## CXO Language : Talk to Your Grandmother



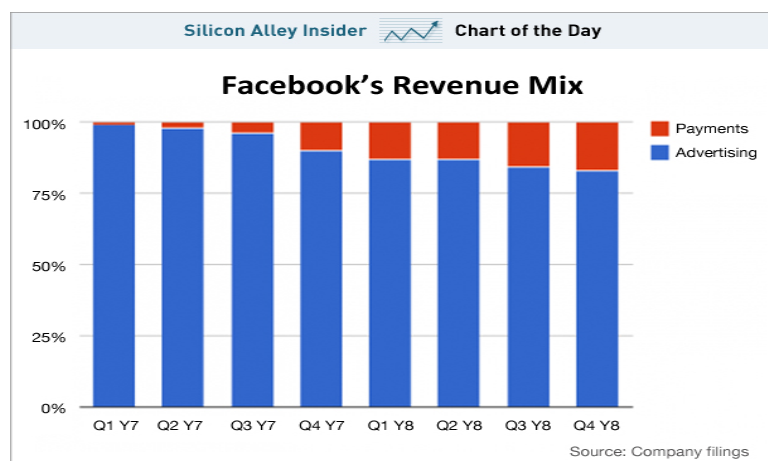
Examples: Value, Position, Strategy, Risk, Short Term, Long Term, Resistance, competition, Quarter...

  - Solution: Classic IT: Test, Small changes, backup, risk mitigation etc.

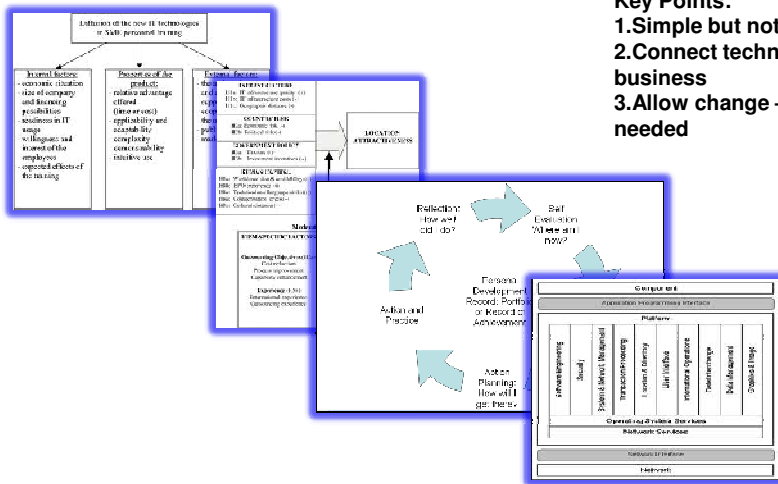

 3. Allow change – update as needed

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








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## IT Touches Everything...
