國際研究機構 Gartner 於澳洲黃金海岸舉辦 ITxpo 2014 會議,提出 未來對企業營運具影響力的十大策略性科技,包括無所不在的運算 (Computing Everywhere)、物聯網(The Internet of Things)、3D 列印(3D Printing)、無所不在但無形的先進資料分析技術 (Advanced, Pervasive and Invisible Analytics)、充分掌握環境的 系統(Context-Rich Systems)、智慧型機器(Smart Machines)、 雲端/用戶端運算(Cloud/Client Computing)、軟體定義應用程式及 基礎架構 (Software-Defined Applications and Infrastructure)、全 球網路規模 IT (Web-Scale IT)、風險控管導向的安全及自我防衛 (Risk-Based Security and Self-protection),提出數位優先(Digital First)概念,並預測至 2020 年間的變化趨勢、資訊長(Chief Information Officer, CIO)們可帶領政府的數位轉型(Digital Transformation) 等。

壹、目的

為瞭解及掌握 2015 年科技發展趨勢,參與 Gartner ITXpo 一年一度舉辦之全球資訊科技業界盛會,主要議題內容包括十大策略性科技的發表,及針對政府機關提出數位政府前十大的策略技術趨勢等,提供資訊長及資訊人員規劃之參考。

貳、報告重點

一、 2015 年數位政府十大策略科技趨勢(Strategic Technology)

Gartner 分析師 Rick Howard 綜整及預測未來數位化政府在技術方面的推展歷程,自 2000 年 E-Government (電子化政府)強調之線上服務、多網站服務、2010 年 Joined-up Government (一體化政府)、2010 年 Open Government (開放政府)強調透明、參與及合作,至 2020 年 Smart Government (聰明政府)強調永續、可負擔承載性及跨領域。(詳圖 1)




圖1:政府應用科技提供服務之各階段歷程

此外,亦分析政府部門在未來 3 年內之科技發展趨勢,提出 10 大策略發展趨勢,包括數位工作場所 (Digital Workplace)、全方位管道公民參與 (Omnichannel Citizen Engagement)、開放任何資料 (Open Any Data)、公文電子身分證 (Citizen E-ID)、優勢分析 (Edge Analytics)、可擴展之互通性 (Scalable Interoperability)、數位政府平台 (Digital

Government Platforms)、物聯網 (Internet of Everything)、全球網路規模 IT (Web-scale IT)、混合雲及 IT (Hybrid Cloud and IT),歸納分類如圖 2。

數位工作場所(Digital Workplace):強調個人化環境及服務,賦與新的、更有效的工作方式,以提高員工的參與性及靈活度,並以公民導向的風格及技術來改變工作本質。(詳圖3)

2. 全方位管道公民參與(Omnichannel Citizen Engagement):提供 24 小時行動存取服務、上下文使用者存取介面、APP與新的商業模式,及 零售業的通路策略(如圖 4)。為提供全方位管道服務,須考量裝置管 理的複雜度、嵌入式社群媒體、個人行動工作區、行動社群關係管理, 且須注意使用介面之多樣性、G2C 服務的共同創造,及公民自助服務之 引入及報導等。




圖 4:全方位管道公民參與示意圖

3. 開放任何資料 (Open Any Data): 開放是新的預設前提, Gartner 預測在 2018年前, 超過 40%的數位政府計畫會把任何資料處理成開放資料。 (如圖 5)




圖 5: 開放任何資料概要




圖7:混合雲及 IT 示意圖






圖 11:物聯網示意圖

10. 全球網路規模 IT (Web-scale IT):網站規模之 IT 建置須重新思考整個 IT 的價值觀,考量連結行動化、雲端、資訊及社群等動力,如以網站導向的架構、工業設計的基礎架構、以速度為中心的流程、密切合作的組織等。此外,要著重開放原始碼、彈性、服務、分享等。(詳圖11)




圖 11:網站規模 IT 示意圖

二、 行動化之重要性

1. 智慧裝置是物聯網普及、鏈接之關鍵

Gartner 分析師 Nick Jones 就「The Mobile Scenario」議題,提及 2018 年關鍵行動及無線技術的市場趨勢、透過雲端技術連結各項穿戴式設備及服務等(圖 12、13),且預估在 2020 年約 50%以上可透過智慧手機(設備)進行直接或間接的通信。

另關鍵設備技術的發展趨勢,包括加速度計、傾角傳感器、生物傳感器、新的藍牙和 Wi-Fi 無線版本、彎曲/柔性顯示器、新的顯示技術,如光子晶體和量子點、多個傳感器、個人生物識別傳感、4K 視頻、模組/組件化設備、…等等。

2014 年至 2020 無線網絡技術的關鍵里程碑,自 2014 年的 LTE-A, 推展至 2020 年的 5G cellular deployment、BeiDou-2,詳如圖 14 所示。




圖 12:網站規模 IT 示意圖




圖 14: 無線網絡技術的關鍵里程碑

2. 行動化設備管理

Gartner 分析師 David Willis 指出,面對越來越多的企業員工使用智慧行動設備,須予以有效的管理。

首先須擬訂相關策略,並建立風險檔案,相關步驟如下:

- (1) 定義因應行動化的組織結構
- (2) 瞭解風險狀況,建立所需的安全控制
- (3) 選擇正確的行動化設備管理方案
- (4) 選擇 EMM (Enterprise mobility management) 系統
- (5) 建立一個完全可控管的設備清單
- (6) 實施 EMM (Enterprise mobility management) 系統
- (7) 定義服務台和支援程序
- (8) 建立及實施教育訓練計劃
- (9) 建立訴訟保留和取證的過程
- (10)建立登記、配置和報廢流程
- (11)分析對基礎設施的影響,及相關升級計畫
- (12) 漸進式的實施




圖 15:BYOD 趨勢

三、 2015 年十大策略科技趨勢 (Strategic Technology)

Gartner 分析師 Nick Jones 預測 2015 年 10 大策略科技趨勢,包括包括無所不在的運算(Computing Everywhere)、物聯網(The Internet of Things)、3D 列印(3D Printing)、無所不在但無形的先進資料分析技術(Advanced,Pervasive and Invisible Analytics)、充分掌握環境的系統(Context-Rich Systems)、智慧型機器(Smart Machines)、雲端/用戶端運算(Cloud/Client

Computing)、軟體定義應用程式及基礎架構(Software-Defined Applications and Infrastructure)、全球網路規模 IT (Web-Scale IT)、風險控管導向的安全及自我防衛 (Risk-Based Security and Self-protection),詳圖 16。

無所不在的運算,及新的模式和定義新技術架構的物聯網,將帶來管理、獲利、營運、擴大四種模式,可成功整合現實世界和虛擬世界。

3D 列印將漸漸普及,包括企業及個人的應用,如工業、醫療、消費等。此外,環境感知加上各式的數據分析,將促使各種智慧型機器的推出,智慧型機器具備認識環境、自我學習、自主行動等能力,如自動車、智慧機器人、虛擬個人助理、智慧型顧問等。

未來企業的 IT 環境會朝大型雲端服務廠商的全球規模運算模式發展,更多企業會如 Amazon、Google、Facebook 般思考及行動。

因應雲端、行動化趨勢,須認知百分之百安全的環境是高難度的,企業及政府應思考透過相關之輔助工具提升安全防護,如運用多層、積極的安全防護觀念,在應用程式方面,亦須加強安全感知及自我防護的能力。




圖 18:巨量資料安全分析是下一代安全平台的心臟

參、心得與建議

Gartner 每一年度舉辦之全球 IT 大會,均就未來的資訊科技趨勢做詳盡的分析及預測,提供政府部門推動資訊相關策略提供規劃方向。

- 一、 CIO 可領導政府在服務方面的數位轉型 Gartner 分析師認為政府部門的 CIO 可透過企業流程的經驗、承上啟下的 技術及政策法規方面的知識,提出創新的服務模式。 以多元化和新的關鍵 IT 角色來推動數位政府,增進政府資訊的價值。
- 二、 善用大數據資料分析

社群媒體普及下,各類的資訊在網路上多元呈現,如何整理出有價值的資訊,除了分析工具外,精確及有效率的判讀、預測亦是重點,如韓國首爾就曾以大數據分析 30 億通的通話紀錄,推出 9 條夜間公車的路線,便利晚歸的民眾可以參考搭乘。

麥肯錫在 2011 年發表的「大數據:創新、競爭和生產力的下一個新領域」報告,明白指出巨量資料將成為競爭的關鍵性基礎。面對浩瀚的各式網路資訊,政府施政在民意上的參考,宜跨出早期民調中心以電話訪談的模式,廣納網路上多元的聲音,提升政府決策的水準,具體改善服務品質及價值。

三、 重新思考數據管理及安全

使用雲端服務時,須重視數據管理的職責,包括 Metadata、品質、整合等等,Gartner 預測至 2016 年只有約 15%的企業會將存儲在雲端的資料做到集中的信息管理功能。

為確保資料存放在雲端的安全及做好必要的管理,須制定管理辦法,如檢視存放在雲端的各資料項目,並預設資料的品質,做好數據整合,以提供資料的再使用及共享。




