

Duties and Responsibilities

Ministry of Agriculture and Cooperatives (MOAC)

Duties: respect to agriculture, water sourcing and irrigation development, agriculturist promotion and development, cooperative system promotion and development, including production process and agricultural commodities, and such other governmental tasks legally designated.

Vision: "To provide agriculturists with good quality of life, people with safe food for consumption, with their generation of income for the land"

Royal Irrigation Department (RID)

Duties: provide the water such as to store and conserve, to regulate, to distribute, to release or allocate water for agriculture, energy, domestic consumption, industry and also including prevention of damage causing by water, and inland navigation within irrigation area.




