



History Naktuinbouw (2)

1 June 1993, introduction Plant Passport inspections
1 January 2006, take over of Plant Breeders' Rights testing from WUR / CGN
1 September 2007, take over of phytosanitary import and export inspections from the NVWA
1 januari 2008, integration Board for plant varieties at Naktuinbouw
1 March 2013, Export (third countries) inspections back to NVWA
