MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MMoU) FOR A MULTI-LATERAL COLLABORATION

For the Exchange of Information and Cooperation

November 2017

Purpose

The signatories to this APEC-VC MMoU:

Considering the cooperation among the APEC Virtual Center for Environmental Technology Exchange (APEC-VC) member economies have continued since the approval of the APEC-VC Project in Osaka Summit Meeting in 1995 and the establishment of APEC-VC in 1997;

Recalling the APEC-VC Gateway website (apec-vc.com) was established in 2014 in order to facilitate more active information exchange among member economies;

Considering the importance of the Internet and digital economies to the future economic growth was recognized by adopting the APEC Accord on Innovative Development, Economic Reform and Growth in 2015;

Desiring to promote the exchange of environmental technology, thus contributing to improvements in environmental technology and environmental conservation within the Asia-Pacific region

Definition

For the purposes of this APEC-VC MMoU:

- 1. "Member economies" means those listed in **Appendix A**, who have signed this Memorandum of Understanding.
- 2. "Secretariat" means the APEC-VC Secretariat hosted by one of the member economies in a term of five years.

Article I Areas of cooperation

- 1 To promote exchange of environmental technology within the Asia-Pacific region, member economies will cooperate in areas of information exchange in environmental technology, industry and conservation
 - 1.1 Member economies will share knowledge and information in areas of environmental technology, industry and conservation through both online and offline information exchange regularly;
 - 1.2 Member economies will participate in online information exchange by uploading data and information on the APEC-VC Gateway Website in accordance with the procedures set forth in Appendix B;
 - 1.2.1 The categories of online information exchange are as follows:
 - 1.2.1.1 Research and Development of Environmental Technology
 - 1.2.1.2 Policy Development of Environmental Technology, Industry and Protection
 - 1.2.1.3 Environmental Technology and Product Information
 - 1.2.1.4 Capacity Building

- 1.2.1.5 Other useful information such as recent news and events in member economies;
- 1.2.2 The information submitted by each member economy for information exchange must be provided in English;
- 1.2.3 The information provided by each member economy must be open data for public use accessible to all;
- 1.3 Member economies will participate in offline information exchange by attending the APEC-VC annual workshop and other related events if necessary;
 - 1.3.1 The annual workshop, hosted by one of the member economies each year, will be consisted for the following:
 - 1.3.1.1 Annual report of each member economy on its APEC-VC activities;
 - 1.3.1.2 Participation in the decision-making process of important APEC-VC related issues;
 - 1.3.1.3 Technical tours or site visits that promotes the development and information exchange of environmental technology, industry and conservation;
 - 1.3.1.4 Other necessary events required for pursuing the objectives of the APEC-VC project;

Article II Responsibilities

- 1 To ensure effective implementation of the information exchange and cooperation activities in this MOU, each member economy will be responsible for:
 - 1.1 Designation of person in charge for APEC-VC activities in each member economy's institution or agency;
 - 1.2 Submission of information in electronic forms to upload to the APEC-VC Gateway website monthly to meet the annual goal allocated to each economy;
 - 1.3 Submission of annual report of each member economy's annual activities in promoting information exchange in environmental technology, industry and conservation;
 - 1.4 Participation in the decision-making process of important APEC-VC activities, such as selection of the Secretariat, extension and termination of APEC-VC project, launch of a new project and other important matters;
 - 1.5 Host annual workshops and be responsible for the related-cost;
 - 1.5.1 Costs incurred for participants' attendance such as accommodation and travel costs can be negotiated to be borne by the participants considering the budget allotted.
- 2 Member economies are responsible for funding their own APEC-VC activities mentioned in article II-1.

Article III Entry into Effect and Termination

1 Cooperation in accordance with this Memorandum of Understanding will begin on

- the date of its signing by the member economies.
- A member economy may terminate its participation in this Memorandum of Understanding at any time by giving at least 6 months prior written notice to the Secretariat.
- 3 This Memorandum will continue in effect for the Secretariat giving notice until the expiration of 30 days after the Secretariat gives written notice to other member economies of its intention to terminate its cooperation under this Memorandum.
- 4 The decision to terminate cooperation by the Secretariat must be made after the consultation and agreement of the majority of member economies.

Article IV Amendments

1 Any amendment of this MMoU is subject to agreement and signature by the member economies listed in Appendix A, upon proposal by the Secretariat for discussion.
