

- Kuehne + Nagel
 Fishery products



Checkpoints

- KLM Animal Hotel Live animals (day old chicks, fishes, dogs, cats, insects or other animals, send to a zoo)
- Schiphol Animal Centre Scription Alimial Centre Live animals (dogs, cats, small mammals, birds, poultry, animals consigned to a zoo, invertebrates)





Products and animals at the checkpoint

- Veterinary (live) products
 Fishery products

 - Meat

 - Milk products
 - Hatching eggs Sperm and embyo's
- Live animals

 - Ornamental fish Dogs and cats
 - Horses
 - Insects

 - Day old chicks Wild and exotic animals





Identity check live animals

- => Does the certifcate belong to the animal?
- Chip number (pets, horses)
- Diagram / passport (horses)
- Label (fish, chicks, insects)







Physical check (visual)

- General impression (locomotion, respiration, digestion, skin, etc.)
- State of health
- Behaviour
- In case of injury (treatment) -> vet from the practice





Physical check

In case of boxes (like tropical fish): 10 %

IATA Live Animal Regulations (LAR) Transport Regulation

Fit to travel (to the destination)





Beside the checkpoints...

- Accidentally 'lost' animals in Cargo
- Welfare in case of export
- Post
- Etc.
- => Arrival hall





Airport terminal



First check by customs 64.000.000 passengers / year



Arrival hall

- Dogs and cats
- Birds
- Reptiles, etc. Animal products (meat, fish, honey)



=> About 120 cases per year



Birds (smuggling)

30 days quarantine

Test for <u>avian influenza</u> and <u>New Castle disease</u>

In case of psittaciformes -> test for <u>psittacose</u>





Dogs and cats

- Health certificate
- Chip
- Rabies vaccination 21 days before departure
 - -rabies vaccination

 - -30 days -blood test
 - -three months



> Return or quarantine
