

SUBJECT: COMMITTEE ON ANTI-DUMPING PRACTICES - INFORMAL GROUP ON ANTI-CIRCUMVENTION - MEETING TO BE HELD ON 1 MAY 2019

1. THE INFORMAL GROUP ON ANTI-CIRCUMVENTION WILL HOLD A MEETING ON THE MORNING OF WEDNESDAY, 1 MAY 2019, COMMENCING AT 10.00 A.M. IN THE CENTRE WILLIAM RAPPARD.

2. THE FOLLOWING ITEMS ARE PROPOSED FOR DISCUSSION, IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE AGREED FRAMEWORK FOR CONTINUED DISCUSSION (G/ADP/M/10, PARA. 110):

- WHAT CONSTITUTES CIRCUMVENTION?
- WHAT IS BEING DONE BY MEMBERS CONFRONTED WITH WHAT THEY CONSIDER TO BE CIRCUMVENTION?
- TO WHAT EXTENT CAN CIRCUMVENTION BE DEALT WITH UNDER THE RELEVANT WTO RULES? TO WHAT EXTENT CAN IT NOT? AND WHAT OTHER OPTIONS MAY BE DEEMED NECESSARY?

3. AUSTRALIA WILL SHARE ITS EXPERIENCE REGARDING THE CONDUCT OF ITS ANTI-CIRCUMVENTION INVESTIGATION.
