SUBJECT: COMMITTEE ON ANTI-DUMPING PRACTICES - WORKING GROUP ON IMPLEMENTATION - MEETING TO BE HELD ON 2-3 MAY 2019

1. THE WORKING GROUP ON IMPLEMENTATION OF THE COMMITTEE ON ANTI-DUMPING PRACTICES WILL MEET ON THURSDAY, 2 MAY 2019 AT 10.00 A.M. IN THE CENTRE WILLIAM RAPPARD CONTINUING ON FRIDAY, 3 MAY 2019 AS REQUIRED.

2. THE TOPICS THE GROUP WILL DISCUSS ARE ISSUES RELATING TO (I) GATHERING AND EXAMINATION OF EVIDENCE FOR THE DETERMINATION OF A CAUSAL RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE DUMPED IMPORTS AND THE INJURY TO THE DOMESTIC INDUSTRY; AND (II) ASSESSMENT OF DOMESTIC INDUSTRY'S ECONOMIC INDICATORS IN THREAT OF INJURY ANALYSIS.
