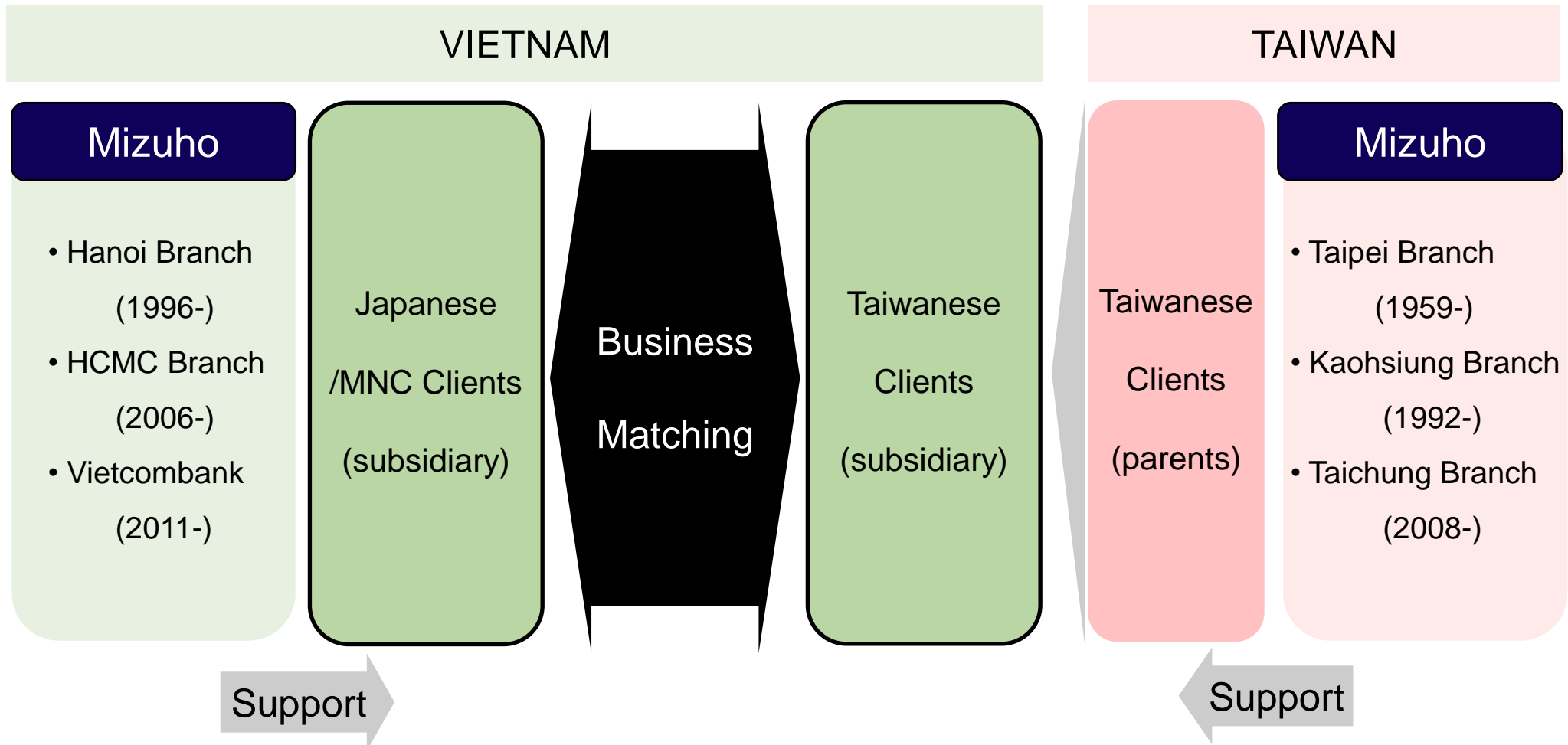

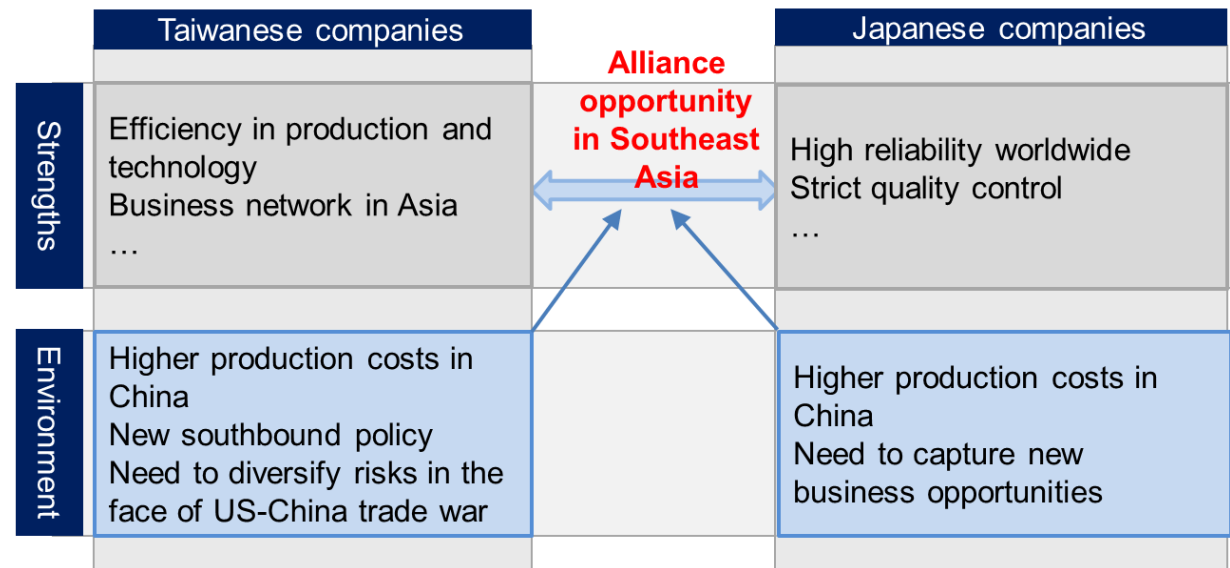
MOU was signed between <MIZUHO> and “TAITRA in May 2019

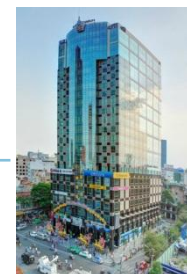

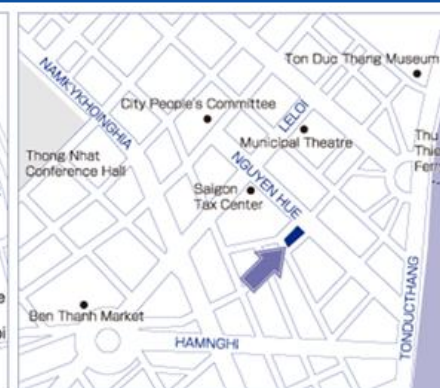

History of Mizuho's Offices In Taiwan

| 1922 | Japan Kangyo Bank Taipei Branch opened. Later, branches were opened in Kaohsiung, Taichung, Tainan, and Hsinchu |
| 1946 | Withdrawal from Taiwan market. Operations transferred to Land Bank of Taiwan. |
| 1959 | Japan Kangyo Bank Taipei Branch opened. First foreign bank to enter Taiwan. |
| 1971 | Name changed to Dai-Ichi Kangyo Bank Taipei Branch due to merger. |
| 1992 | Dai-Ichi Kangyo Bank Kaohsiung Branch opened. |
| 1996 | Fuji Bank Taipei Branch opened. |
| 2002 | Through merger, became Mizuho Corporate Bank (currently Mizuho Bank.) |
| 2008 | Taichung branch opened. |

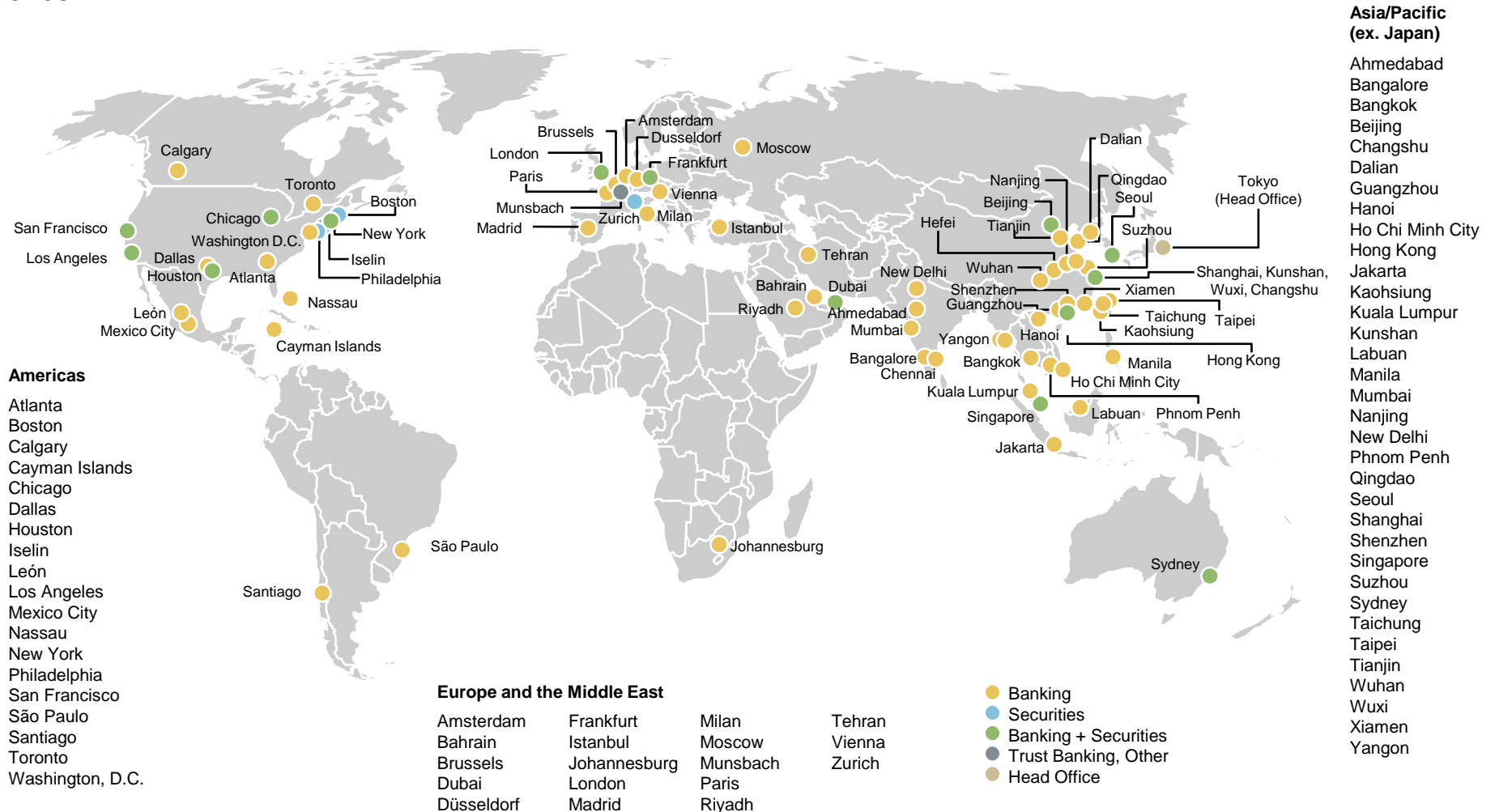
Mizuho's Offices in Taiwan
