貳、防衛委員會會議

本（2021）年4月26日召開防衛措施委員會例行會議，會議重點摘述如次。

一、審查防衛法規通知

審查巴西、聖克里斯多福及尼維斯及美國等會員之通知，另美國於會前已對玻利維亞、喀麥隆、賴比瑞亞、英國及辛巴威等提出書面提問，僅玻利維亞提供書面回復。

二、續審前次會議未完成之防衛法規通知

審查哥斯大黎加、迦納及肯亞等會員之通知，美國於會前已提出書面提問，惟皆未獲回復。

三、審查防衛措施通知

審查會員實施中的防衛措施（自去年10月例會迄今）共26案，重要討論案件如下：

(一) 歐盟特定鋼品延長防衛措施案

歐盟因應英國脫歐，調整進口特定鋼品防衛措施關稅配額(TRQs)，自本年1月1日起施行，並於本年2月26日公告展開延長SG措施調查。中國大陸、瑞士、印度、日本、巴西、韓國、俄羅斯及土耳其等會員呼籲歐盟於該措施到期(本年6月30日)後應不予延長，綜整會員意見如下：COVID-19疫情時代，應以貿易合作取代限制措施，全球過剩產能須靠多邊貿易解決，且歐盟措施對下游產業供應鏈亦造成影響。依據SG協定第7.2條規定，防衛措施對防止或救濟嚴重損害有繼續之必要始得延長，惟歐盟未徹底執行逐步自由化、TRQs亦未用罄，顯示歐盟缺乏法律基礎繼續延長措施。歐盟表示將遵守SG協定規定，刻正依程序進行調查，歡迎會員於調查認定前提供任何評論或進行雙邊諮詢。

(二) 海灣國家合作理事會(GCC)特定鋼品防衛措施案

會中日本呼籲GCC調查程序應符合SG協定並審慎作出決定；韓國及烏克蘭先後指出，GCC未依SG協定第4.1條、第4.2條規定，以客觀證據認定調查期間進口量突然、急劇及顯著增加致國內產業嚴重損害，韓國並認為本案難謂協定中之未可預見發展，呼籲GCC調查應符合SG協定認定之要件；印度認為GCC新增產品範圍違反SG協定規定；瑞士則對GCC更改產品範圍對於損害認定之影響表達關切，重申其於2019年會議對本案之書面關切，目前僅得到GCC部分回應，將持續關注本案後續發展，最後呼籲GCC所作之損害認定應符合SG協定之要求。

(三) 菲律賓汽車防衛措施案

日本、泰國、韓國、歐盟及印尼皆對菲律賓採行之臨時措施表達關切，日本認為該措施未符合GATT 1994第19條第1項第a款因未可預見之發展採行緊急行動之規定；韓國指出本案之未可預見發展、進口量增加及嚴重損害或嚴重損害之虞認定未符合SG協定定義之基準，應終止該措施，泰國亦持相同看法；菲律賓則請各發言會員提供書面評論，俾供調查機關於最後認定前參考。

(四) 烏克蘭鮮切玫瑰防衛措施案

厄瓜多表示烏克蘭尚未回復其去年提問，厄瓜多於本次例會進一步提出4項質疑：1.依據SG協定第5.1條規定，採行防衛措施應僅足以防止或救濟嚴重損害及促進調整所必要之程度，惟烏克蘭過度保護其國內產業，對本案課以重稅，對厄瓜多及其他國家之出口商造成衝擊；2.依據SG協定第4.2條第b款規定，嚴重損害之認定必須依據客觀證據之調查顯示，涉案產品之進口增加與嚴重損害或有嚴重損害之虞間具有因果關係，惟烏克蘭未完整指出進口與損害之因果關係；3.依據SG協定第12.3條規定，應提供與出口涉案產品具有實質利益之會員事先諮詢的機會，惟烏克蘭未盡通知之責，剝奪利害關係人回應之權益；4.依據SG協定第3.1條規定，主管機關應公布書面報告，詳載其所發現之事實及所有關於事實與法律爭點所推理之結論，惟烏克蘭卻未公布，逕採行SG措施；哥倫比亞亦對調查程序提出相同質疑，並表示烏克蘭採行為期3年之防衛措施，首年稅率高達139.7%並不合理。烏克蘭則強調會員可提出雙邊諮詢之請求，並請發言會員提供書面評論，俾利其綜整相關資訊後回復。

四、修訂通知格式

WTO 防衛委員會於本年3月2日召開非正式會議，討論巴西提出修訂SG協定通知格式案及主席提出整合通知文件案。本次會議討論如下：

(一) 主席整合通知文件提案

主席提案整併現行文件G/SG/2與G/SG/1/Rev.2、G/SG/N/6/Rev.2、G/SG/89/Rev.1格式，俾利會員調查使用通知文件，會中英國、巴西、加拿大、俄羅斯、澳洲及美國等國皆發言表達支持，本案決議通過。

(二) 巴西修訂通知格式提案

巴西提出會員於展開調查階段，即公布SG協定第9.1條開發中國家會員清單之提案，俾利開發中國家會員充分行使其實力。英國、印度、俄羅斯及我國表示有助透明化並協助開發中國家會員因應。美國則維持其於非正式會議之反對立場，表示難於初步調查階段提供資訊，且可能涉及機密資料不適宜公開，SG協定9.1條已有開發中國家會員之豁免規定，SG協定12.3條亦提供與出口涉案產品具有實質利益會員諮詢之機會以解決會員疑慮。加拿大亦支持美國，中國大陸及澳洲則表達實務執行上有困難。主席裁示，鑑於會員需要更多時間思考，本提案將請下次會議主席持續跟進。

五、英國對特定鋼品之防衛措施

瑞士、巴西、韓國、中國大陸、土耳其、日本及俄羅斯陸續於會中表達，英國因脫歐情勢變更（自歐盟 28 個成員國退出成為單一國家），英國應依 SG 協定規定重新展開調查並作出是否採行措施之認定，而非於過渡期間未通知 WTO 會員之情況下，直接延續採行歐盟措施，此舉欠缺法律基礎，且不符合 SG 協定規定，並呼籲英國過渡期終止（2020 年 12 月 31 日）後即應終止措施。

英國回應過渡期即進行措施檢討，係採用歐盟貿易統計方法計算英國貿易占比，減少歐盟原 26 項鋼品品項，並於去年 10 月表示可能依調查結果於本年 6 月作出繼續採行或廢止之決定，歡迎各會員國參與調查程序，英國已通知 WTO 本檢討措施案，並將繼續遵守 SG 協定相關規定。

六、下次會議日期為本年 10 月 25 日當週。

參、補貼及平衡措施委員會相關會議

本年 4 月 27 日依序召開特別會議及例行會議，會議討論重點摘述如次。

一、補貼及平衡措施委員會特別會議

(一) 審查 2019 年全新及完整之補貼通知

審查智利、哥倫比亞、哥斯大黎加、瓜地馬拉、宏都拉斯、以色列、馬來西亞、納米比亞及沙烏地阿拉伯王國等會員之補貼通知。

(二) 審查 2017 年全新及完整之補貼通知

審查哥倫比亞及納米比亞等會員之補貼通知。

(三) 審查 2015 年全新及完整之補貼通知

審查納米比亞之補貼通知。

(四) 審查2013年全新及完整之補貼通知

審查納米比亞之補貼通知。

(五) 審查2011年全新及完整之補貼通知

審查納米比亞之補貼通知。

(六) 續審查未完成2019年全新及完整之補貼通知

續審查智利、中國大陸、歐盟、墨西哥、菲律賓、俄羅斯、美國及越南等會員之補貼通知。其中美國、加拿大及歐盟就中國大陸表示「無必要答復會員詢問本項通知文件以外之補貼措施」提出批評，認為不符委員會審查會員通知之目的且有損透明化。中國大陸表示倘會員詢問事項與通知內容無關，應依SCM第25.8條程序進行，並舉出其回應澳洲及歐盟所詢事項之比例高達9成，此說明中國大陸已盡其所能回應會員各項提問以提升其透明度。

(七) 續審查2017年全新及完整之補貼通知

續審查中國大陸及墨西哥等會員之補貼通知。會中美國詢問中國大陸是否同意依入會議定書承諾於其商務部公報中發布包含地方政府在內之所有補貼資訊，中國大陸回應其公報已包括中央及地方政府之補貼措施並對美國關切其透明化表達感謝。

(八) 續審查2015年全新及完整之補貼通知

續審查中國大陸全新及完整之補貼通知。

(九) 續審查2009年全新及完整之補貼通知

續審查加彭全新及完整之補貼通知。

二、補貼及平衡措施委員會例行會議

(一) 審查新修訂或前次通知之平衡措施法規

審查阿根廷、巴西、加拿大、印度、秘魯、聖克里斯多福及尼維斯、土耳其、美國、玻利維亞、喀麥隆及英國等會員之最新或修正法規通知。其中對於美國之通知文件討論如下：

1. 美國修正其不受禁止性補貼條款拘束之開發中國家會員清單

巴西就美國貿易代表署（USTR）修正開發中國家與低度開發國家清單，並依其分類標準排除巴西特殊待遇資格之適用，呼籲美國尊重WTO會員自我認定開發程度地位之作法，並表示巴西雖已宣布未來談判中將不再援引特殊差別待遇，但不應影響既有協定之承諾。

2. 美國認定匯率低估 (currency undervaluation) 為補貼

巴西及中國大陸對美國將匯率低估作為課徵平衡稅之理由並認定經濟體中從事貨品貿易之企業符合SCM第2.1條特定性規定中所指一群 (group) 事業或產業之作法表達關切，認為美國新法違反協定規定。巴西認為匯率低估非財務補助 (financial contribution) 也不具特定性，中國大陸指出GATT第15條已明定匯率相關議題應交由IMF等專門機構處理，WTO並非處理該等議題之場域。

美國則回應SCM協定並未限制WTO會員作出他國匯率低估構成補貼而課徵平衡稅之認定，且SCM附件1(b)款已將涉及出口獎勵的通貨保留 (currency retention) 列為出口補貼，顯示WTO並非無法處理匯率議題之場域。另美國認為其釐清特定性「從事國際貿易買賣商品的企業」即屬「一群事業」(a group of enterprises) 之定義並未違反SCM規定。中國大陸表示後續將密切關注美國實際執行情形。

(二) 繢審查前次會議未完成之平衡措施法規通知

續審查哥斯大黎加、迦納、肯亞及賴比瑞亞等會員之法規通知。

(三) 審查平衡措施半年報

審查會員之平衡措施半年報 (2020年7月1日至12月31日)，包括澳洲、巴西、加拿大、中國大陸、歐盟、印度、墨西哥、秘魯、土耳其、英國、美國及越南等12個通報實施平衡措施之會員。會員關切重點包括：

1. 中國大陸半年報：澳洲表示，雖然中國大陸最終未對其葡萄酒作出課徵平衡稅之決定，惟調查過程存在產業定義不明確、抽樣調查標準失當等瑕疵，爰對中國大陸相關調查作法之合理性提出質疑，將持續與中國大陸透過雙邊管道進行諮詢。美國對中國大陸未於正丙醇 (n-Propanol, NPA) 案之最終認定調整其構成補貼認定之調查方法表達遺憾，呼籲中國大陸對其他化學產品之調查案勿採行相同作法。中國大陸回應其調查機關透過利害關係人問卷回復獲取必要資料，利害關係人應於調查程序中充分合作，惟本案利害關係人未能提供石油等補貼計畫之詳細資料，爰調查機關依不利可得事實(AFA)所作之最後認定係客觀、公平公正並符合WTO規定。
2. 英國半年報：中國大陸及俄羅斯對英國延續部分其於歐盟時期之平衡措施表達關切，脫歐過渡期已於2021年1月1日零時結束，呼籲英

國未經重新調查前，應立即終止相關措施。

3. 美國半年報：俄羅斯關切美國對其磷肥及無縫鋼管展開平衡稅調查，俄羅斯表示其政府及指定受調廠商皆提供未受政府補貼之證據，認為美國僅因俄羅斯政府持有部分股份即認定其為公立機構（public body）之理由並不充分，另認為美國對其補貼計畫事實上（de facto）是否具備特定性之分析方法與SCM第2.1條(c)款規定不符。中國大陸關切美國平衡稅之調查方法及認定的判斷標準，認為美國未充分考量個案於中國大陸內部市場資訊即認定其市場扭曲，逕依不利可得事實（AFA）使用第三國價格作為比較基準，對指定受調廠商極不公平。摩洛哥認為該政府及出口商已充分配合美國調查，美國未能證明摩洛哥之出口造成其國內產業損害仍作出課徵平衡稅之決定與SCM協定規定不符，並呼籲美國撤銷該不公平措施。

(四) 改善通知之時效性與完整性以及其他貿易措施資訊

有關美國就SCM協定第25.8條及第25.9條所提之改善通知案修改如G/SCM/W/557/Rev.4，會員就書面請求其提供或說明補貼相關資料，應儘速提供書面回應（即會員應考量其與地方政府必要之諮詢時間，儘可能於收受提問後60日內提供書面回應），後續提問應儘可能於收受後30日內以書面回應，所有提問應全面完整答復並提供充分詳細資料俾供會員檢視是否符合協定規定，未予回應之提問將循SCM協定第25.9條程序，提報委員會並列入議程直至答復為止。歐盟、英國、澳洲、加拿大、紐西蘭、日本及我國發言肯定本提案有助於提升透明度並表達支持，中國大陸表示該提案除增加準備相關通知之工作量外，亦無法聚焦，對本案續持反對意見。

(五) 中國大陸潛在鋼鐵補貼問題（歐盟及美國提出）

美國及歐盟質疑中國大陸之補貼通知內容與中國大陸公司自我揭露接受政府資助之情形不一致。會中美國依據SCM第25.8條規定請求中國大陸說明其6大鋼鐵公司年報揭露至少160項政府補貼或補助之計畫，並表示自2017年4月提問後遲遲未收到中國大陸回應，即使與中國大陸政府聯繫後亦然，歐盟亦請求中國大陸對該提問予以回應。中國大陸回應年報中多項補貼計畫係屬同一政策計畫，美國則進一步建議中國大陸應將年報揭露之各項補貼計畫與應行通知之特定補貼計畫予以連結，將有助

於提案國進一步釐清。

(六) 中國大陸入會議定書承諾之補貼透明化及中國大陸之公告與諮詢窗口義務（歐盟及美國提出）

美國表示中國大陸應依入會議定書承諾於其商務部公報中發布包含地方政府在內之所有補貼資訊，惟中國大陸卻經常未公布補貼措施，中國大陸亦承諾諮詢窗口應於收受提問30天內回應，惟實務上仍有遲至45天回應之個案，呼籲中國大陸應恪守其入會承諾之義務。歐盟、英國及加拿大亦接續呼籲中國大陸應遵守義務並致力於透明化。

(七) 補貼及產能過剩（加拿大、歐盟、日本及美國提出）

1. 美國引述OECD近期「衡量國際市場的扭曲：低於市場行情之融資」報告（Measuring distortions in international markets: Below-market finance），該報告針對2015年至2019年全球13個產業之前306家大型製造業者之公開資料進行分析，發現鋼鐵、造船及鋁業等由政府出資之企業占比甚高，受益於低於市場行情之財務支援（如政府資本投資、低利貸款等）集中於鋁業、水泥、玻璃、太陽能面板、鋼鐵及造船等製造業，尤以中國大陸企業受惠最多，而該些產業近年均呈現產能過剩情形。報告指出，具政府股權企業之商業決策有別於私人企業，以低利貸款為例，政府出資企業可能選擇大舉投資，願承擔較高之投資風險，接受較低之投資報酬。報告亦顯示此類低於市場行情之資金援助與製造業產能擴增高度相關，此與提案國強調補貼措施導致產能過剩之論點一致。該報告並強調應強化政府提供低於市場行情貸款或資本投資予政府股權企業之資訊透明度。

2. 俄羅斯認為造成產能過剩原因多元，會員應同時檢討是否濫用貿易救濟手段。巴西、挪威及澳洲等國表達支持提案國論點，認為有檢討補貼協定及加強國營企業規範之需要。英國表示將持續關注本議題並期待與各會員進行討論。中國大陸則表示其鋼、鋁產能已逐年下降，政府並提出產能置換實施辦法以解決產能過剩問題，政府亦未提供企業低於市場行情之財務支援，依據中國商業銀行法規定，各項營運決策皆由企業自行決定，實行自主經營，自擔風險，自負盈虧，不受政府介入。

(八) 下次會議日期為本年10月25日當週。

肆、反傾銷委員會會議

本年4月28日召開反傾銷委員會例行會議，會議討論重點摘述如次。

一、審查新修訂反傾銷法規通知

審查阿根廷、巴西、加拿大、喬治亞、印度、秘魯、聖克里斯多福及尼維斯、土耳其、玻利維亞、喀麥隆及英國等會員之反傾銷立法或修法通知及會員書面提問。

二、續審查前次會議未完成之反傾銷法規通知

續審查哥斯大黎加、迦納及賴比瑞亞等會員之反傾銷法規通知。

三、審查會員反傾銷措施半年報

(一)主席宣達反傾銷通知網站已於本年1月啟用，會員可自行上傳半年報或援例提供秘書處電子檔或紙本，並請會員就其使用網站之情形反饋改善意見。

(二)審查會員之平衡措施半年報(2020年7月1日至12月31日)，包括阿根廷、亞美尼亞、澳洲、巴林、波札那、巴西、加拿大、智利、中國大陸、哥倫比亞、多明尼加、埃及、史瓦帝尼、歐盟、印度、印尼、以色列、日本、哈薩克、韓國、科威特、吉爾吉斯、賴索托、馬達加斯加、馬來西亞、墨西哥、摩洛哥、納米比亞、紐西蘭、阿曼、巴基斯坦、秘魯、菲律賓、卡達、俄羅斯、沙烏地阿拉伯、南非、我國、泰國、土耳其、烏克蘭、阿拉伯聯合大公國、英國、美國及越南等通報實施反傾銷措施之會員。會員關切重點包括：

1. 澳洲半年報：俄羅斯關切其硝酸銨 (ammonium nitrate) 落日調查報告公布時間，盼澳洲不要延長措施。中國大陸關切澳洲頻繁針對類似產品重複進行調查，於2020年對6個會員計27項產品展開雙反調查，係世界上展開最多貿易救濟調查之國家之一，中國大陸指出澳洲於2020年對多項產品展開反傾銷調查，部分產品範圍與已課徵反傾銷稅產品重疊，並關切澳洲於鋼鋁調查案中有關正常價格之判斷方法，呼籲澳洲應謹慎展開調查。

2. 加拿大半年報：俄羅斯關切混凝土鋼筋 (concrete reinforcing bar) 調查案，認為加拿大無充分證據證明進口俄羅斯產品造成其國內產業受損之因果關係，依據AD協定第5.8條規定應立即終止調查；並質疑加拿大未依據AD協定第2.2條規定逕對俄羅斯採推算正常價格且無充分證據證明傾銷。另依據AD協定第7.1條規定調查機關對於

防止調查期間發生損害判斷有其必要時始得適用臨時措施，呼籲加拿大應遵守相關協定規定。

3. 中國大陸半年報：澳洲質疑葡萄酒反傾銷案之申請人資格、國內產業範圍、使用可得事實等調查過程。日本關切中國大陸對不鏽鋼、熱軋鋼板案之認定範圍過廣且損害因果關係之認定忽視進口產品與國內產品之銷售對象不同。中國大陸回應，因澳洲指定受調廠商不合作、未完整答卷，調查機關依可得事實作出最終認定係符合AD協定規定。另有關日本提出鋼品產品範圍議題，中國大陸表示調查機關已於調查期間給予利害關係人陳述意見之機會並妥為考量後據以認定。
4. 菲律賓半年報：土耳其認為菲律賓對其麵粉（wheat flour）落日檢討最終認定違反AD協定第5.8條傾銷差額微量（*de minimis*）應立即終止調查之規定，呼籲菲律賓應遵守協定相關規定。
5. 烏克蘭半年報：土耳其關切烏克蘭對其水泥等調查案利害關係人通知義務。依據AD協定第12.1條規定，調查機關發動反傾銷調查應通知利害關係人；另依據第6.9條規定，調查機關為最終認定前，應告知所有利害關係人其決定是否採行最終措施所依據作為認定基礎之基本事實，該項事實之公開應有充分的時間，讓當事人為其利益辯護。土耳其表示烏克蘭僅給予利害關係人3-4個工作天對其報告提出評論，考量各項文件須翻譯之前提下很難依限完成，呼籲烏克蘭應依協定規定給予利害關係人合理時間。
6. 英國半年報：中國大陸及俄羅斯等呼籲英國於脫歐過渡期結束後應立即終止延續實施原歐盟之反傾銷措施。
7. 美國半年報：歐盟關切美國鋁合金之反傾銷課徵產品範圍過廣且對部分產品課徵稅率過高並不合理，該高稅率係因美國要求於極短時間提供額外資料致出口商被認定不合作而依不利可得事實（AFA）計算，另歐盟認為損害並非因進口量增加而是由COVID-19疫情影響等其他因素所造成。烏克蘭關切其鋼鐵案之損害認定並與歐盟持相同論點。俄羅斯關切碳鋼及合金鋼管案之反傾銷稅率不合理，認為其廠商所提供之證據未被充分考量，美國逕依可得事實計算導致過高之反傾銷稅率。中國大陸則批評美國使用反傾銷措施及加徵

232鋼鋁國安關稅，為多重貿易保護措施，造成全球市場扭曲。

8. 日本對中國大陸、歐盟、印度、印尼、韓國、墨西哥、泰國及美國等對其多項產品(主要為鋼品)實施超過5年之反傾銷案提出關切，由於該些產品經落日檢討後仍繼續課徵反傾銷稅，日本呼籲會員應遵守AD協定第11.3條有關實施期間與落日檢討之標準與規範。
