

SUBJECT: COMMITTEE ON ANTI-DUMPING PRACTICES - INFORMAL GROUP ON ANTI-CIRCUMVENTION - MEETING TO BE HELD ON 27 APRIL 2022

1. THE INFORMAL GROUP ON ANTI-CIRCUMVENTION WILL HOLD A MEETING IN THE MORNING OF WEDNESDAY, 27 APRIL 2022. THIS MEETING WILL BE HELD IN PERSON AND VIRTUALLY VIA INTERPREFY. DELEGATES ARE INVITED TO REFER TO THE AIRGRAM OF THE COMMITTEE ON ANTI-DUMPING PRACTICES (WTO/AIR/ADP/35) FOR DETAILS REGARDING LOGISTICS FOR THE PARTICIPATION IN THIS MEETING.

2. THE FOLLOWING ITEMS ARE PROPOSED FOR DISCUSSION, IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE AGREED FRAMEWORK FOR CONTINUED DISCUSSION (G/ADP/M/10, PARA. 110):

- WHAT CONSTITUTES CIRCUMVENTION?
- WHAT IS BEING DONE BY MEMBERS CONFRONTED WITH WHAT THEY CONSIDER TO BE CIRCUMVENTION?
- TO WHAT EXTENT CAN CIRCUMVENTION BE DEALT WITH UNDER THE RELEVANT WTO RULES? TO WHAT EXTENT CAN IT NOT? AND WHAT OTHER OPTIONS MAY BE DEEMED NECESSARY?

3. THE UNITED STATES WILL MAKE A PRESENTATION REGARDING ITS AMENDED ANTI-CIRCUMVENTION REGULATIONS.

4. MEMBERS OF THE WTO AND OTHER GOVERNMENTS WITH OBSERVER STATUS ARE REQUESTED TO INFORM THE SECRETARIAT OF THE NAMES OF THEIR REPRESENTATIVES AS SOON AS POSSIBLE.
