
Introduction

- DTG based on CIML Resolution 2021/07 (esp. Addendum 4.4)
- The DTG is
 - a strategic Task Group,
 - a horizontal Task Group looking at the various OIML activities, and
 - a contact point for other International Organisations signing the Joint Statement of Intent coordinated by the BIPM
- The DTG's major purpose is to analyze the challenges of the digital transformation of the various legal metrology processes and activities, and prepare respective proposals





Motivation: product lifecycle




Physical products with digital information (digital certificate, digital twin, cloud platform, etc.)

- Consultation with existing OIML project groups working on OIML documents with "SMART" in mind


