


LaGuardia Airport


- Operated by Port Authority of New York & New Jersey (PANYNJ)
- PANYNJ leading \$8B redevelopment of LGA
- 3 Terminals:
 - Terminal A: Historic building not part of redevelopment
 - Terminal B: Developed and managed by LaGuardia Gateway Partners
 - Terminal C: Developed and managed by Delta Airlines

LaGuardia Airport

- LGA is 8 miles from Manhattan
- LGA is primarily a domestic airport – while EWR and JFK offer both domestic and international service
- LGA serves more than 30M passengers/year, with approximately 50% from Terminal B

Transformational Project

Terminal B Replacement Project:

- One of the largest public-private partnerships in US aviation history
- Project valued at \$5.1B
- 6-year project finished on time and on budget in 2022
- One of the most complex airport construction projects undertaken
- Kept original 1960's era terminal operational while building next to it, behind it and even over top






Innovative Construction Phasing

Our Goal:

Reduce the impact of construction on existing operations while accelerating the schedule for completion

Our Approach:

- Build a new terminal while operating the existing one
- One phase of construction within the existing road network
- Build island concourses and bridge connections to reduce the impact of construction



LaGuardia Gateway Partners

The New Terminal B

- 1.3M square feet
- 35 gates
- 3,100 space parking garage with for-hire-vehicle meeting area
- Dual pedestrian bridges connect to gates over active taxiway
- Added 2 extra miles of taxiway to airport



Airline Benefits

Improved reliability and efficiency of operations:

- Common use
- Gates accommodate multiple aircraft type (up to Group 3)
- Check-in facility flexible enough to evolve with technological improvements
- Terminal B airlines: Air Canada, American, JetBlue, Southwest and United






Guest Benefits
