 - ✓ specific indicators based on each ME's respective situation such as measured by the UN/FAO Food Waste Index (FWI) or other appropriate index, and
 - ✓ promote public-private investment in infrastructure and cold chain to reduce the current levels of food loss and waste and review progress in this area by 2025.
