The Korean Dental Association (KDA)'s 100th Anniversary International Congress and Dental Equipment Exhibition is being held at Songdo Convensia in Incheon from November 11th to 13th.

KDA was founded on June 9th, 1925, and carries on the spirit of Korea's first dentist, Dr. Ham Seok-tae, and other esteemed senior dentists.

Over 6200 Korean dentists have registered for this commemorative event, with attendees from abroad including Dr. Greg Chadwick, President of the FDI(World Dental Federation), and delegations from 10 countries.

International Attendees Enjoy K-Dentistry with AI Interpretation

Lecture by FDI President Greg Chadwick NDA Forum on Dental Policies for Elderly Patients in 18 Countries Latest Clinical Practices by Renowned Korean Speakers Featured Prominently

The Korean Dental Association' s 100th Anniversary International Congress is operating AIinterpreted lecture halls to ensure that international attendees can comfortably listen to lectures. These halls feature a concentration of the latest clinical lectures by renowned speakers from Korea.


On the first day of the congress, the 11th, there was a session to reflect on the history of the Korean dental community and consider future directions for development. Policy lectures were also held, led by professors who guide Korean dental education, to share various ideas for the advancement of Korean dentistry and the Korean dental licensing examination system. Notably, Dr. Greg Chadwick, President of the World Dental Federation (FDI), delivered a lecture on the topic 'The International Association for Dental Education: Not an Option, but a Necessity and an Opportunity.'

From the lectures on the 12th onwards, attendees can go to the lecture halls where AI interpretation is provided. Interpretation will be available in lecture halls 204-205, 107-109, and

116-118. In lecture halls 204-205, notable lectures include 'Periimplantitis - Long term clinical results and selection to overcome the limitation of surgical treatment' by Cheolwoong Jeong Director (Chumdan Mir Dental Hospital) and Periodontal aspects on anterior regions' by Prof. Dong-Woon Lee (Wonkwang University).

In lecture halls 107-109, we recommend 'My vantage points after four decades in periodontal therapy' by Prof. Young Ku (Seoul National University) and 'Reevaluation of periodontal surgery in the implant era: Periodontal surgery that a general practitioner can try' by Kyoung-man Min Director(Seoul Mai Dental Office). In lecture halls 116-118, we recommend Innovative Digital Solutions for Full Mouth Rehabilitation' by Prof. Chalmongkon Peampring (Faculty of Dentistry, Prince of Songkla University) 'Where are we with digital RPDs?' by Prof. Ji-Man Park (Seoul National University), and 'Key points for each step of endodontic treatment' by Seungho Baek Director (Baek & Heo Dental Clinic).

In particular, attendees interested in dental policies related to elderly patients in

On the 13th, interpretation will be provided in the Premier Ballroom(A+B) and lecture halls 204-205 and 116-118.

In the Premier Ballroom, there

will be 'Factfulness: Something that We're Wrong about the Wisdom tooth' by Hyungmo Kim Director (Wise Wisdom tooth Oral Surgery Clinic). In lecture halls 204-205, there will be 'Paradigm Shift: GBR should be easier' by Jaeyoon Kim Director (Yeonsu Seoul Dental Clinic). In lecture halls 116-118, there will be 'Predictable 3D Building GBR using Tent Screw by Pilseong Kim Lecturer (UCLA School of Dentistry), Immediate Implant Loading' by Ken Kim Prosthodontist (Army Dental Corps), and 'Updates on vital pulp therapy' by Prof. Kyung-San Min (Jeonbuk National University), all of which are expected to be engaging.





Discover the History and Flavors of Incheon

Chinatown: A Top Destination for Exploring the Open Port's Heritage Songdo New City: A Vibrant Hub for Shopping and Dining

Incheon is the city in Korea that first embraced Western culture. In the late 1800s. various Western countries, including China and Japan, which flocked to Incheon Port, referred to Incheon as 'Chemulpo' and established their residential areas in the region stretching from present-day Incheon Station to Sinpo Market. This area is known as the Open Port.

The railway line that starts from Incheon Station and connects to Seoul is called Line 1, and it is Korea's first urban railway line. Incheon expanded and developed its city along the stations of Line 1, starting from the Incheon Station area and heading towards Seoul. Currently, Incheon's population is 3.03 million, making it the second-largest city in South Korea after Seoul.

Chinatown is located right in front of Incheon Station, and it offers a variety of Chinese restaurants where you can taste Chinese food adapted to Korean palates. The most famous dish is jajangmyeon, made with Chinese-style soybean paste. Jajangmyeon is a fusion Chinese dish developed by Chinese people living in Chemulpo during the enlightenment period to provide cheap and filling meals to workers near the port.

The hill where Chinatown is located is called Jayu Park. The statue of General Douglas MacArthur at the top of Jayu Park is also famous. Incheon is renowned as the area where U.S. General Douglas MacArthur, who led the Allied Forces during the Korean War (June 25, 1950 - July 27, 1953), reversed the tide of the war with a surprise landing operation. The statue commemorates this history. From the top of Jayu Park, you can enjoy a panoramic view of Incheon's old downtown area.

The streets leading from Jayu Park to Sinpo Market are filled with charming cafes, restaurants, and various

attractions. Sinpo Market is famous for its dakgangieong(sweet and sour crispy fried chicken), dumplings, and tteokbokki(spicy rice cakes). Dakgangjeong is a dish of fried chicken coated in a sweet and spicy sauce.

Incheon tour

If you cross a major street from Sinpo Market, you'll find Dapdong Cathedral, Korea's first Catholic church. The cathedral was built in Chemulpo by the decision of French Bishop Blanc and was completed in 1897.


The 'Wolmi Culture Street,' located 4km away from Chinatown, is also a major tourist attraction. The seaside area is densely packed with seafood restaurants, cafes, amusement park rides, and small hotels. It's a popular destination for people from Seoul who want to see the ocean quickly.

Incheon Songdo New City, where the Korean Dental Association's 100th anniversary event is being held, is an international city developed in conjunction with the growth of Incheon International Airport. Songdo New City was originally a sea area, and large-scale reclamation work began in earnest in 2003. It has been developed into a city with global competitiveness in various fields, including international business, medicine, education, and tourism. Songdo Convensia opened in October 2008 and hosts a variety of exhibitions and events.

Near Songdo Convensia, you can enjoy shopping at Hyundai Premium Outlet, and a variety of restaurants are located around Central Park,

across from Songdo Convensia. Many of Korea's famous actors and singers reside in

If you want to enjoy raw fish and alcohol while experiencing the atmosphere of the port city of Incheon in the evening, I recommend 'Mammoth Seafood Center' (17, Yeonanbudu-ro 33beongil, Jung-gu, Incheon) at Yeonan Pier. The seafood center has a concentration of various raw fish restaurants, and you can enjoy seafood dish sets at affordable prices. There is also a largescale seafood market across from the seafood center.
